

# Friends of Karen Bike Tour, "Journey of the Heart"

### Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement September 25, 2021

In consideration of participating in the Friends of Karen Bike Tour (the "Tour"), I represent that I understand the nature of cycling events and that I am qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such an activity. I acknowledge and agree that if I believe event conditions are unsafe, I will immediately discontinue participation in the activity. I will ensure that my bicycle is in good working condition and I will wear a protective helmet at all times while riding. Furthermore, I will comply with instructions as provided by the Tour supervisors, I will follow the stated Tour route, and I will not embark until support crew is in place and the Tour route is officially opened.

I fully understand and agree that cycling events are inherently dangerous activities that involve risks of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death, which may be caused by my own actions or inactions, those of others participating in the event, the conditions in which the event takes place, or the negligence of the "RELEASEES" named below or other causes; and that there may be other risks either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, costs, and damages I incur as a result of my participation in the Tour.

I am fully aware of the risks involved with participating in the Tour during the COVID-19 pandemic, as well as with respect to contracting COVID-19 or any related or similar infection or illness (which together are herein referred to as "COVID-19"), and I understand that Tour is not requiring me to participate and am choosing to do so voluntarily. I am entering into this waiver knowingly and on my own behalf.

As a condition of my being allowed to participate in the Tour I will fully comply with: (i) all local, state and federal requirements and (ii) any other health and safety requirements communicated by the Tour. If I test positive for COVID-19 or am exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the fourteen (14) days prior to the Tour, I agree that I will not participate in the Tour.

I hereby release, discharge, and covenant not to sue Friends of Karen, Inc. (the event coordinator) as well as its respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers, employees, other participants, additional sponsors, advertisers and, if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the activity takes place (each considered one of the "RELEASEES" herein) from any and all liability, claims, demands, losses, causes of action or damages of whatever kind or nature, arising from or related in any way to my participation in the Tour caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the "releasees" or other causes, including negligent rescue operations; and I further agree that if, despite this release, waiver of liability, and assumption of risk I make a claim against any of the RELEA-SEES, I will indemnify, save, and hold harmless each of the "RELEASEES" from any loss, liability, damage or cost which may be incurred as the result of such claim, including reasonable attorney's fees. I acknowledge that this waiver will prevent me from filing suit, for arbitration or making any claims (including for damages) against the releasees in the event of illness, injury or death relating to my participating in the Tour in connection with COVID-19.

I acknowledge that the risks involved with participating in the Tour and being in the presence of other people during the COVID-19 pandemic include, but are not limited to, contracting COVID-19, respiratory failure, death, and transmitting COVID-19 to family or household members and others who may also suffer these effects. Notwithstanding the foregoing, I elect to voluntarily participate in the Tour with full knowledge that doing so may be hazardous to my health and those whom I may come into contact with. I voluntarily assume full responsibility for any risks of loss or personal injury, including serious illness, injury or death, that may be sustained by me or by others who come into contact with me, as a result of my participating in the Tour during COVID-19, whether caused by the negligence of the RELEASEES

I have read this Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement. I understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it and have signed it freely and without inducement or assurance of any nature and intend it to be a complete and unconditional release of all claims and liability to the greatest extent allowed by the law and agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid the balance notwithstanding shall continue in full force and effect.
